Grades 2-6

Time commitment: workshops are 30-45 minutes.

Tech requirements: projector, speakers.

TELUS Wise in control

Grades 6-12

Stay in control of your online reputation.

TELUS Wise in control engages students in a discussion about cyberbullying, identity theft, protecting and positively growing your online reputation, and more.* The program presents a series of digital literacy scenarios that illustrate the do's and don'ts and tips and tricks of managing your online reputation and personal brand.



Time commitment: workshops are 1 hour.



Program delivery: hosted by a TELUS Wise ambassador or teacher. In-class or assembly presentation.



Tech requirements: projector, speakers.

TELUS Wise impact

Grades 6-9

Make an impact when you witness cyberbullying.

Also co-created with MediaSmarts, TELUS Wise impact engages students in a conversation around cyberbullying, helping them explore and understand different options for safe and appropriate ways of intervening when they witness cruel behaviour online. A supplemental lesson plan and posters for your classroom are available to help extend the learning from the workshop.



Time commitment: workshops are 45 minutes to 1 hour.



Program delivery: hosted by a TELUS Wise ambassador or teacher. In-class or assembly presentation.



Tech requirements: Internet connection, projector, speakers.



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*Please note that this workshop explores the consequences of sharing intimate images. This scenario can be omitted upon request.
