## Definition

a malicious attempt to obtain sensitive information like usernames, passwords, credit card details and money transfers via email or phone, disguised as a trustworthy company.

control who can and cannot see your profile and posts.

being cruel or intentionally embarrassing someone online, spreading rumors, sharing or liking humiliating or intimate photos.

your core values, beliefs, talents.

the exact latitude and longitude of photos, videos and posts online.

control what can and cannot be accessed and shared about you by a social networking site or mobile app that you subscribe to.

your full name, phone number, full date of birth, social insurance number, student ID, fingerprint.

software intentionally designed to cause damage to a computer, smartphone, tablet or computer network.

the beliefs and opinions made about you based on what information can be found about you online.

a Canadian cyberbullying law that makes it illegal to distribute intimate images of a person without their consent.

using someone else's personal, private information to impersonate them for financial gain and/or to commit crimes.
